A Message from Vern Bendsen, President Elect

Now that Spring is here and Summer is just around the corner, one does not want to think about bylaws. But we must.

For the past several years, your Executive Committee has been trying to make our IOBG into a member oriented organization. An organization that will give the members a voice and choice of what we are.

In June 2008, you voted to change the number of votes your Directors had. This change gave each District a better representation of votes according to the number of members in each District. In 2009, you voted for the Code of Conduct to be added to our Bylaws. Now you are asked to vote for a major change to the IOBG Bylaws that will make the Bylaws even more member oriented. You will have a louder voice and more choice in the decision making process.

The major changes to the Bylaws are:

- * * * A Finance Committee will be added. No longer will it be the President Elect who makes the budget for the coming year.
- * * * The Directors nominated for Districts 50 and 51 will be will be chosen by the Area Vice Presidents and the Directors from the District's area.
- * * * The Nominating Committee shall consist of the President, the two Immediate Past Presidents, one Blue Gavel Member from East of the Mississippi River and one Blue Gavel Member from West of the Mississippi River. These two members will be selected by the AVP's and District Directors from their areas. Their terms will be for two years. That means that each year, the Nominating Committee will have two new members; one new Past President, one new Blue Gavel Member.
- * * Nominating from the floor, does not give the membership an opportunity to advise their Chapter Presidents and District Directors their choice for each office. So, there will be no more nominating from the floor. At the Summer Regional Meeting, the Nominating Committee will, as always, announce the slate of officer for the following year. If anyone wants to run for an office he/she will have 30 days in which to send the IOBG Secretary, a petition for the office he/she is running for. That person's name shall appear on the ballot with the Nominating Committee's recommendations. This will give all members of the IOBG a chance to see all the candidates for each office. And let their Director know who to vote for.

It is up to you, the individual members of the IOBG, to tell your Chapter President and District Directors your choices for each office. Your Directors must vote the way you tell them .

The changed bylaws will go into effect on January 1, 2011.

The Bylaw changes will be voted on by a mail-in ballot. This is the way it will happen.

The number of votes the District Directors will have for the mail-in ballot, will be determined by the number of paid members each District has as of April 15, 2010.

By May 1st, each voting member of the Board of Directors, the District Directors, the Area Vice Presidents and the Executive Committee will receive by mail, the ballot for the proposed Bylaws changes with the pros and cons for the changes. The proposed Bylaw changes are on our web site.

The Directors should contact all their Chapters to see how their Blue Gavel members want them to vote.

Remember, it is you, the Blue Gavel member, who directs your District Director how you want him or her to vote.

All the ballots must be mailed back to our International Operations Center - IOC - by May 31st. The ballots will be counted at the Spring Regional Meeting in Portland, Oregon.
